

## Lochmara Lodge Artist Residencies

Each season we invite applications for short term residencies at Lochmara Lodge. The residency programme allows artists to be resident at Lochmara to work on a specific project, to be inspired by Lochmara and the Marlborough Sounds, and to interact with our New Zealand and overseas guests.

### The purpose of the programme is twofold:

- a) To support the development of New Zealand art by providing opportunities for artists in all stages of their career to undertake a residency, with a focus on inspiration, dedicated time, and making art accessible to new audiences.
- b) To provide an opportunity for national and international visitors to learn about New Zealand art and the creative process by talking to artists and watching them work.

### Residencies in 2011/12 will:

- Be from 1 – 3 weeks long and occur between 8 September 2011 and 4 June 2012 according to availability.
- Include agreed times each day where the artist will be available to the public.
- Include information about Workshops, Artists Talks or other additional forms of availability to the public as proposed by the artist, and agreed to in advance.
- Result in new work to be exhibited for sale at Lochmara, or credited to Lochmara in accordance to the minimum value of the residency as negotiated with Lochmara.
- Please be prepared with an artist's statement, the length of one A4 page, to assist in any promotion prior to your arrival, and to accompany your artwork.

### Residencies will include:

- Accommodation for the artists will be in the loft of the Art Studio, or at Crumpy's Camp by arrangement.
- A small stipend of \$100/week towards food and other associated costs. The stipend might be exchanged for upgraded accommodation in shoulder season dates from September - November or April-May (strictly according to availability) if necessary.
- Kitchen facilities are available, and resident artists are eligible for 50% staff discount in the cafe (except alcohol) while in residence.
- Use of the Lochmara Art Studio and equipment if desired, although resident artists can choose to work anywhere on the 14 acre Lochmara property.
- Water transfers to/from Picton at the start and end of the residency.
- Print and online promotion of the residency, with a focus on the local market.
- Access to display work in the Huia Exhibition Space, and on a feature wall of the Lochmara Cafe for the duration of the residency as desired.

**Costs:**

- Artists are expected to meet their own costs for travel to Picton and any costs above the stipend agreed to. Costs of materials and any shipping of work and/or materials to/from Lochmara (as far as Picton) is also the responsibility of the resident artist.
- One hour of internet is provided per week to facilitate needs for the purposes of the residency. Additional internet use is provided at \$7 per hour.
- Provisions are difficult to access from Lochmara. Please discuss all your potential needs with the Arts Co-ordinator to avoid disappointment during your stay.

**Applications and Selection**

The programme is open to serious and professional artists at all stages of their artistic career. Applications are welcomed from artists working across the arts, including but not limited to: sculpture, photography, writing, performance, music, dance, weaving, painting, film-making, and jewellery, etc.

Applications must include a current CV and a completed Residency Application. Full terms and conditions of the residency will be negotiated with successful applicants. There is no deadline for applications, but residencies will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Early expression of interest and prompt application are recommended.

**What to bring if chosen:**

- Camera
- Any necessary supplies for the execution of your art practice
- All food supplies (there is no shop at Lochmara)
- Toiletries
- Towel
- Sleepingbag or bedding
- Torch
- Sunblock, Bug Spray
- Walking shoes
- Swimming togs
- Laundry powder (coin operated machines \$2.00 washer, \$2.00 dryer)

(There is no television at Lochmara and mobile phone coverage is sketchy)
